Dear Mayor Malanka:

Ontario has heard directly from the municipal sector that operating impacts due to the pandemic will continue in 2021. In order to respond to municipal need and to further strengthen our communities, we are now investing an additional \$500 million to help municipalities respond to ongoing and unprecedented 2021 COVID-19 operating pressures. While the actual extent of municipal impacts for 2021 are uncertain at this time, the province expects that this funding will help municipalities continue to deliver the high-quality local services that residents and business rely on, as well as help municipalities proceed with planned capital projects in 2021.

I am pleased to inform you that the Government of Ontario has committed financial support to the **Township of Augusta** through the 2021 COVID-19 Recovery Funding for Municipalities program in order to support your COVID-19 operating costs and pressures. All municipalities in Ontario are eligible for this program and the level of funding is based on the proportion of COVID-19 cases in the Public Health Unit for your respective municipality during the period of January 1, 2021 to February 18, 2021. I have reviewed the eligibility criteria for provincial assistance under the program and have determined that accordingly, your municipality will receive \$57,116.00, subject to your municipality returning a copy of this letter, signed by your municipal treasurer, to the ministry by March 31, 2021. You will receive these funds in two equal instalments – one instalment on or before May 1, 2021 and the other on or before November 1, 2021.

Please note that your municipality is accountable for using this funding for the purpose of addressing your priority COVID-19 operating costs and pressures. If the amount of the funding your municipality receives exceeds your 2021 COVID-19 operating costs and pressures, the province's expectation is that your municipality will place the excess

funding into a reserve fund to be accessed to support any future COVID-19 operating costs and pressures.

The province realizes that municipalities are facing financial impacts due to the COVID-19 pandemic and that in some instances, this provincial funding will not be sufficient to cover all municipal operating impacts due to COVID-19. The province expects municipalities to do their part by continuing to find efficiencies in their operating services and using existing reserves and reserve funds that have been specifically put aside for such unforeseen circumstances.

Your municipality will be expected to provide two report backs on your COVID-19 operating impacts and the use of these funds as follows:

- An interim report in June 2021, which will include:
 - a) Use of funds provided last year under the Safe Restart Agreement –
 Operating funding stream; and
 - b) 2021 estimated COVID-19 operating impacts and how your municipality plans to use the funding under the 2021 program.
- A final report back in Spring 2022.

We had previously indicated that Safe Restart Agreement reporting would be expected in March 2021. However, we have decided to streamline this reporting and the new 2021 COVID-19 Recovery Funding for Municipalities program. The template for this report back will be provided by the ministry with more details to follow in the coming months. While the province expects your municipality to complete this report, your second instalment under the 2021 COVID-19 Recovery Funding for Municipalities program is not contingent on the province receiving your interim report.

At this time, I am requesting that your municipal treasurer sign the acknowledgement below and return the signed copy to the ministry by email to: Municipal.Programs@ontario.ca. If the province has not received your letter on or before March 31, 2021, you will not be eligible for this program and your municipality's allocation will not be paid. In order to allow for processing time, please provide your signed letter to the ministry on or before March 24, 2021.

Our government continues to stand with our municipal partners as we have throughout the pandemic, advocating for funding for communities from the federal government to support local economic recovery. Communities may need more COVID-19 related operating funding in the coming year, and we will continue to advocate on your behalf to the federal government. I encourage you to contact your local Member of Parliament to seek further federal support in order to help municipalities deal with their operating impacts due to COVID-19.

The government thanks all 444 Ontario municipal heads of council for their support throughout the pandemic and our ongoing partnership in Ontario's economic recovery.

RE: Request for a Letter of Support (Bell's Universal Broadband Fund Application)

AUTHOR: Bryan Brown, Chief Administrative Officer

RECOMMENDATION: THAT, Council for the Corporation of the Township of Augusta provide Bell with a letter of support for their application to the Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada's Universal Broadband Fund (UBF).

PURPOSE:

To expand broadband internet coverage to more residents and businesses within the Township of Augusta.

BACKGROUND:

The Government of Canada has recently created the Universal Broadband Fund (UBF) to provide broadband internet service providers the opportunity to apply to their Fund in order to assist such companies improve/expand broadband service to areas that are currently underserviced. The Township of Augusta is currently one of those underserviced areas.

Bell is proposing to submit an application to the UBF to deliver such services to a number of underserviced areas, one of which is the Township of Augusta.

Bell's proposal includes the following technology:

- A commitment to deploy Fibre to the Premises (FTTP) in eligible areas of the Township of Augusta,
- FTTP is a full wireline solution that provides residents and businesses with access to Internet, TV and phone services over a direct fibre connection and
- Residents and businesses would have access to internet speeds of up to 1.5
 Gigabits per second (Gbps) for downloads and up to 940 Megabits per second
 (Mbps) for uploads.

Bell's coverage would include;

- There are currently 40 residents within the boundaries of the Township of Augusta who have a high speed, direct fibre connection with Bell,
- Based on their current planning and eligibility data, their UBF proposal would cover approximately 1,700 of the Township's 3,300 or so homes/business locations.

- These are locations that do not currently have access to broadband internet services and/or fail to meet the minimum speed threshold of 50/10 Megabits per second (Mbps) established by the Government of Canada and
- Actual coverage will be dependent on the specific contract terms and detailed design/engineering if Bell is a successful applicant to the UBF.

ANALYSIS:

Currently the residents and businesses of the Township of Augusta have very limited access to high speed, direct fibre internet connection. We are advised by Bell that this initiative would occur at no cost to the Township.

POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

There are no policy implications.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

There are no financial implications for the Township.

CONSULTATION:

Other companies have communicated with the Township about the possibility of submitting a similar application for to the Universal Broadband Fund.

THAT Augusta Council recommend to the Land Division Committee of Leeds and Grenville that consent application B-147-20 (Morrison) be approved, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the balance of any outstanding taxes, including penalties and interests, (and any local improvement charges, if applicable) shall be paid to Augusta Township.
- 2. That the applicant is to submit an acceptable reference plan, survey, or legal description of the severed lands and the deed or instrument conveying the severed lands shall be submitted to Augusta Township.
- 3. That the road allowance of Skakum Road be widened as required to 10 metres from the centreline of the road, and that a Transfer/Deed conveying the said land to Augusta Township be prepared, at the applicant's expense, and executed in consideration of the payment of \$ 1.00.
- 4. Applicant to submit a cash-in-lieu of parkland levy of \$500 to the Township.
- 5. Applicant to demonstrate that sufficient quantity/quality of water is available for the severed parcel.
- 6. Applicant to provide confirmation to Augusta Township that the utility agency associated with the easement running through the proposed severed lands, as identified on the site plan provided, supports the proposed severance.
- 7. That favourable comments are received from circulated commenting agencies.

PURPOSE:


The United Counties of Leeds and Grenville's Consent Granting Authority has received a severance application, B-147-20 (Morrison), to create one new 2.0-acre residential building lot at 5749 Skakum Road, legally described as Concession 4, Part Lot 3 (see Attachment 1).

The new parcel being proposed would have approximately 137.2 metres of lot depth and 60.1 metres of lot frontage, which is about twice the required road frontage for a new lot in the Rural zone.

BACKGROUND:

As shown in the aerial image and site plan on the following page, this location is approximately 185 metres southwest of County Road 18, and 325 metres northwest of the Domville settlement area. The existing 36.0-acre parcel has Rural zoning and approximately 190 metres of road frontage.





ANALYSIS:

This property has Rural zoning in both the Augusta Official Plan and Zoning By-law. This severance application meets the minimum requirements for lot area and road frontage identified in Augusta's Zoning By-law for the Rural land use zone and is in close proximity to other residential dwellings.

This severance application conforms with the intent of the Provincial Policy Statement (2020), the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville Official Plan, the Augusta Official Plan and the Augusta Zoning By-law to enable rural severances and associated residential development.

The site location for the proposed severance has been reviewed internally by Augusta's Planner, Chief Building Official, Public Works Manager, and Fire Chief.

POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

There are no implications for current policies.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

There are no budgetary requirements for the Township.

OPTIONS

- 1. Support the severance application proceeding to the Land Division Committee based on the Planner's recommendation as written.
- 2. Support the severance application proceeding to the Land Division Committee based on the Planner's recommendation with revisions.
- 3. Do not support the severance application.

CONSULTATION

One nearby resident wrote in as part of the United Counties' public consultation to express a concern about drainage in the vicinity of the subject lands. The applicant's agent provided a response, which has been confirmed by site visit, indicating that fill will need to be brought in to enable construction, as multiple other property owners in the vicinity have done successfully. The Township requires site plans and drainage plans in association with various building and planning applications.

This application was reviewed and discussed by the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee on February 3, 2021. Committee members discussed the application, along with the neighbour's drainage comments and agent's response, and support the application proceeding with the recommended conditions.

LINK TO MUNICIPAL PLANS

The recommendation aligns with the rural severance provisions and development objectives of Augusta's Official Plan and Zoning By-law.


