

By Law Number 680

For Restraining and Regulating the Running at large or trespassing of Cattle Horses Sheep Swine and all kinds of domestic fowl,

The Corporation of the Township of Augusta Enacts as follows, 1st Any person who shall suffer or permit any Horse Mare Colt Cow Bull calf sheep goat pig or other Cattle, being the property, or under control of such person to run at large on any of the public roads or highways or on other persons' premises ^{within} the limits of the Township of Augusta, shall on summary Conviction, before any Justice of the peace, having jurisdiction in this Municipality be liable to a penalty, for each Bull \$5.00 fine Dollars Ram two Dollars Boar two Dollars Stallion over one year old \$5.00 five Dollars any other horse Mare or Colt \$2.00 two Dollars, or Cow calf sheep goat pig, or other Cattle 50^{cts} fifty cents

2nd Any person who shall suffer or permit any Turkeys, Geese, hns Ducks or other domestic fowl being the property or under control of such person, to run at large or trespass on any other persons' premises ^{within} the limits of the Township of Augusta, shall be liable to a penalty, on summary Conviction before any Justice of the peace having jurisdiction in the Municipality of Augusta for each Turkey twenty cents, goose fifteen cents for each hns duck chicken or other domestic fowl ten cents;

By Law number 458 and all other By Laws or sections of By Laws inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed
