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

Question 1: Has the proponent; H and D Properties submitted all necessary permits as required by the MECP for review by the Twp Building Inspector prior to work commencing? Has the Township issued any building permits for work undertaken for the period 2020 and 2021 at 1336 County Rd 2? Have the necessary conditions required by Construction Safety Act, the township building permit process, been verified as being fully satisfied? If not, what action is the Township taking to correct this oversight? Has the township reported this lack of permitting to the MECP? Has work on the site been stopped until all permits are in place?

Question 2: The proponent; H and D Properties has sought approval from the MECP for a Waste Disposal Facility. He plans to ship large volumes of waste from PQ and ON for processing in anaerobic digesters. Large volumes of waste (sludge) will be inventoried on site then shipped offsite and stored elsewhere: that too requires MECP approval. This is described on permit submissions as a waste disposal operation, the input and outputs are waste including green house gases methane, CO2, H2S and a multitude of odours of decomposition.

Please explain how a waste operation is permitted in an industrial zone and why the Township did not notify residents when this process started in 2019 or earlier. We feel that this should and could have been stopped as early as 2018/19 if the public had been properly informed per by-law and request that it be stopped now, that the Township confirms with records that due process was and shall be followed regarding this property.

Dear Karen; Building Inspector Augusta Twp

H and D Properties Inc: Mr Don Duncan is undertaking demolition at 1336 County rd 2 and has for some time. Local contractors have been engaged in work there for at least one year.

I would expect that Mr Duncan provided the township building office with all the necessary permits required by regulators such as the MECP before the Township Building office issued a Building Permit to start the work and has inspected the site for compliance.

There is no posted building permit and its very clear to me that he may be exposing the neighborhood to wind blown asbestos from this pile of old insulation that he has removed from the plant.

I respectfully ask that you take corrective action now and shut down the site until your office issues a permit only when you are fully satisfied that all the required MECP and regulator permits, and assessments are done by competent persons.

The following regulates Brownfield demolition and other activities.

DuPont and other corporate citizens in the township know the regulations, employ competent people to assess the work and then obtain the necessary permits.

The plant is hidden from view, and it appears that Don Duncan will do what ever he wants as if he is working in a hayfield.

It is my contention that work is underway at 1336 County rd 2 and that work is being done without the necessary permitting in place. If permits are in place they are not posted in accordance with the regulations.

On August 3rd I called Karen Lavigne, Twp Building Inspector and left a message with my concerns.

The Augusta Township Planning and Building Officials should know that a building permit is required, and or if issued is not visible as mandated. Twp Building Officials should also know that other authorities may require permitting also.

To the best of my knowledge a Ministry of the Environment Conservation and Parks (MECP) Environmental Permit to alter a Brownfield Site is required. If it has been obtained it is not visible, it has not been posted and neighbors have not been notified.

Until this issue is resolved any further work on the site must be stopped.

Re: A Waste Disposal Site (Anaerobic Digester) Has the Township Authorities Approved or Endorsed this Use?

Dear Sirs,

The proponent, H and D Properties Inc; Mr Don Duncan, has made a submission to the Waste Management branch of the MECP, to install a "Waste Disposal Site including Anaerobic Digesters" as described by these two MECP requests, ERO 019-2185 and ERO 019-2772.

The submissions describe significantly more waste haulage than he communicated to neighbors in his letter of June 21, 2021. He did not communicate:

- 1. He plans to truck in wastes from sources in ON and PQ down county rd 15 along county rd 2.
- 2. He stated waste in at 660 tonnes per day but has applied for 1200 tonnes in per day.
- 3. He made no mention in either document of 1200 tonnes of waste out per day.
- 4. He made no mention of an increase of truck traffic on county rds calculated by us at 240 transports/day on a 24x7 basis.

We are concerned that the Official Plan and or a Zoning By-Law has been changed to permit Waste Collection and Processing without notification as mandated by law.

We are also concerned that a Township Official may have endorsed a proposal for 1336 County Rd 2, that does not conform to the Official Plan.

Therefore, we need to know if 1336 County rd 2 is or has been the subject of a Zoning or Land Use discussion with Township Officials? Have any fees been paid to process an any application specific to this address in accordance with Augusta By-Law 3164-2015?

Is there a public record of council or township discussion, agreements and or endorsement of this proposal at any time in the last 5 years?

This Waste Site proposal will cause destructive and irrevocable harm to this neighborhood and township.

Residents are concerned that this Waste Site proposal has been endorsed by Township Officials and Council without due process as required by law.







Potential exposure

H/s is a gas therefore it is most likely to be breathed in. Skin and eye contact may also occur. The nervous system and cardiovascular system are most affected by H/s, leading to a range of symptoms such as nausea, headache and distiness. The physiological response is rapid, even one or two breaths at elevated concentrations can cause 'knock down'. Single exposures to very high concentrations may rapidly cause breathing difficulties and death. * In New Zealand, sanitation workers are most at risk from exposure to H₃S, especially when working in or near confined spaces such as sewers, septic tanks and sump holes. Geothermal areas, such as Rotorius, also pose risks to the general public. There have been 11 deaths linked with H₃S exposure in spa pools and confined spaces (hotels) in New Zealand between 1946 and 2008. ^{III}

Vulnerable populations

Vulnerable populations include asthmatics, the elderly and young children with compromised respiratory function since the respiratory tract is the major target organ of H₂S toxicity. ¹¹

Managing health risks

If H₂S is suspected or detected (distinctive rotten eggs smell):

- Use an H₂S monitor to determine concentrations. Do not enter a confined space, or descend to a lower area, without first checking levels;
- Use personal protective equipment (eye wear, gas mask) if concentrations > 1 ppm;
- Eliminate the source of H₂S wherever possible. If flushing with fresh air, ensure venting to open space where other people will not be exposed;
- Keep the general public away.

Do not rely on the sense of smell to indicate the presence of H₂S or to warn of harmful levels.

One south London waste-processing plant has been slapped with several odour-related charges by Ontario's environment ministry — the latest south-end business accused of running afoul of provincial law.

The Free Press has learned Ontario's Ministry of Environment and Climate Change has charged Stormfisher Environmental Ltd. with 11 provincial offences, stemming from incidents between June and November 2016.



StormFisher was charged with seven counts of discharging a contaminant, namely odour, into the environment on seven different dates in the summer and fall of 2016, provincial offences court documents obtained by the Free Press show.

The company is facing three counts of failing to comply with provincially mandated operational regulations as well. Two of the charges involved not keeping doors at the facility closed at all times, and the other relates to the company not having the equipment required to cope with a power failure.

The waste-processing facility is also facing one charge of failing to notify the ministry about a spill and the actions taken to fix it on July 18, 2016.

StormFisher, which received notice of the charges Thursday, is preparing to address the accusations.

"We're just assessing this right now with out attorney to understand next steps," said Brandon Moffatt, vice-president of development.

The 2.85 megawatt biogas facility on Green Valley Road near Wilton Grove Road and Highbury Avenue converts up to 100,000 tonnes of organic waste — specifically food refuse — into energy and fertilizer each year.

StormFisher is just one of the south-end businesses at the centre of smell complaints from neighbours. Another nearby organic waste processor, Orgaworld, was slapped with a \$1.1-million fine in October after pleading guilty to nine charges of discharging a contaminant laid by the ministry. The Orgaworld charges stemmed from incidents that happened between 2014 and 2017.

The latest round of charges is welcome news for Allan Tipping, a Dingman Drive homeowner who's led a local coalition against the chronic stench.

"I've talked to some other neighbours about it and they're very happy," he said. "This isn't just one person complaining that they've smelled odour once. This has been ongoing."

The provincial offence charges against StormFisher come as the city embarks on a summer pilot project to measure the stink in the south end using a mechanical odour-detecting device, a response to mounting public pressure from neighbours.


Legal worries have temporarily stalled a municipal plan to tweak the public nuisance bylaw to include odour. If passed, the amendment would pave the way for bylaw officers to ticket people or businesses that create nasty smells.

The proposed municipal bylaw change would work parallel to laws enforced by Ontario's environment ministry.

Tipping wants the provincial charges against StormFisher to embolden the city to take swift action on its own bylaw change.

"It's time for the city to wake up and see. Now we've got two facilities in the south end of the city that have had major charges," he said. "How much more evidence does the city need that there's an issue out here?"



After 10 years of suffering an unbearable stench, residents living near a giant compost facility in south London may be getting some answers.

The city's planning committee has approved a staff report recommending measures to alleviate the stench.

The committee heard from a full gallery, with more than a dozen Brockley-Shaver area residents sharing concerns.

They call it stomach turning — like standing next to the corpse of a dog that has been rotting for three days.

Imagine that being the smell when you step outside for a family barbeque.

One of the worst parts, says Dingman Drive resident Deborah Conner, is that you never know when the putrid smell will hit, or for how long.

She's one of several hundred residents of south London who are hoping the city can help with the smells stopping her from enjoying her property.

She lives within wiffing distance of a giant compost facility owned by Orgaworld, which takes in organics from Toronto, York region and St. Thomas, as well as commercial compost from Metro grocery stores and organics used by local farmers for crop management.

Also nearby is a biogas facility and the city's landfill, all of which can create unpleasant smells that blow onto nearby properties, depending on which way the wind is blowing and what is being processed.

City recommendations

The planning committee approved the following city staff recommendations at the meeting:

- Telling Toronto and York region that the city wants "action or further action with respect to odour challenges."
- · Asking Orgaworld to restart a committee which works with residents

- Asking the Middlesex-London Health Unit to provide a health opinion about the odours coming from the waste management facilities
- Asking the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change, which is responsible for regulating the facilities, to give annual updates about compliance.

City staff will also report back to the committee with proposed amendments to the city's nuisance bylaw to address the odour concerns raised.

"As a city here, we just want to see businesses operating, working and living in harmony with the community, and that has not been the case, unfortunately," said Jay Stanford, the city's director of environmental services and solid waste.

'We want the city to take a stand'

David Gillis lives less than a kilometre from Orgaworld. When it first opened 10 years ago, it was billed as an odourless facility.

Now, Gillis is a decade into his fight against the smell coming from the company.

Prior to Monday's meeting, Gillis said the city had not taken a stand.

"They've left it to the Ministry of the Environment. We want the city to take a stand and comes up with a solution to this problem. This is affecting our property values, our enjoyment of our properties, and our health," Gillis said.

He wants the plant to shut down.

Since Orgaworld Canada opened in 2010, it has been charged with 33 offences. Ten are still before the courts, a Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change spokesperson said.







Board of Health Meeting July 22, 2021

Summary

COVID-19 UPDATE

- The number of new infections is low throughout the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark area with no new COVID-19 infections since July 14. This reflects the broad adherence to public health precautions and provincial regulations, and the high level of vaccine uptake by our population.
- The Delta variant is now dominant among new infections in Ontario. The Delta variant is causing severe disease among younger adults as well as older ones who aren't immunized, with the need for hospitalization and respirator support. A significant number of people have long-term complications of the infection.
- Fall is usually a time of increases in all respiratory infection more people are indoors and the drier air leads to an increased risk of transmission of viruses. Given how easily the Delta variant can be spread with close contact it is critical that people receive two doses of the vaccine now for protection in the fall and beyond.
- A key message is that it is important to continue to follow precautions if you have one or even two vaccine doses. We need to keep protecting each other until we are all fully vaccinated. o Masks are still required in indoor spaces and outdoors in public events where you can't maintain a 2 m distance from others.
 - o Physical distancing is required indoors at a business or service that is open to the public.
 - o People who are fully immunized can make decisions about social interactions with others without a mask and closer than 2 m considering the risk and with mutual consent. See https://healthunit.org/health-information/covid-19/gatherings-social-circles/

VACCINE UPDATE

- 87% of LGL residents 12+ have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine and 71% have received both doses. The percent with second doses is increasing quickly with an 11% increase from the previous week. We have been at or near the top of health units in the province for several weeks for the percent of the population 12 + with first doses and second doses.
- Check out our vaccination dashboard which is updated every Tuesday. We show the percentages of first and second doses for each age group on the dashboard.
- The 12 to 17 age group now has 71% with one dose and 25% with two doses. It is critical that youth receive their first dose now so they have time to get their second dose 14 days before school starts.
- Given children under age 12 cannot receive the vaccine, it is important that adults around them receive the vaccine to give them protection from the virus.
- Our Pfizer vaccine allocations will increase in July, and we continue to have a supply of Moderna. This will help us provide more opportunities for residents to get first and second vaccinations of both Pfizer and Moderna.
- All clinics now have room for both booked appointments and walks-ins. The clinic dates, times and locations are listed on our website, and our social media posts each day identify the clinics that are open for walk-ins. This combination is working very well and meets the varying needs of the community. An appointment can be booked through the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark online booking portal or by calling the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark Call Centre at 1-844-369-1234
- As of August 31, 2021, the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit and partners will be transitioning to a mobile vaccine clinic program. The current Fixed Site Vaccine Clinics in Almonte, Smiths Falls, Kemptville and Brockville will become part of the mobile program rather than operating on a regular weekly schedule, and some will move to other locations. These clinics have been supported by a number of partners and have provided thousands of vaccinations to residents of LGL as well as other surrounding areas.
- Our staff will be reaching out to those with vaccine appointments booked in September and October to reschedule their appointment in July or August.
- For August, we are also working on a targeted strategy to provide vaccinations at interested LGL workplaces, community organizations, as well as to other groups like sports teams. Interested workplaces and organizations can get in touch with us at contact@healthunit.org.
- We are also working with primary care to identify how we can work together to continue to provide vaccine through the fall.

• Pharmacies have both Moderna and Pfizer and some have AstraZeneca for those who received it as a first dose. Check a participating pharmacy.

HEALTH UNIT RECOVERY PLAN

Dr. Stewart advised that while management and staff are still working very hard on the vaccination program and have been following up on cases and contacts, we recognize that we also need to think about when we are not so heavily involved in COVID-19. This will be the recovery phase of the COVID-19 response and we will move into more emphasis on the Ontario Public Health Programs and Services. We are starting to think about the response and recovery phase and the Management Team has met to start planning and will lead the process.

Planning will involve all employees, the Board of Health, and our partners with a focus on restoration, reconstruction and reimagining. We are emphasizing the reimaging part of it as we have done things differently during COVID-19, for example, we have strengthened our partnerships with municipalities. How do we imagine the public health programs and services that take advantage of these changes? This is exciting and we are not just going back to the way we were doing things – it is the new normal.

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council direct staff to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to undertake a Compensation and Job Description Review.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to obtain Council's direction to issue an RFP for Compensation and Job Description Review for non-union staff.

BACKGROUND:

In 2020, the Township undertook a Service Delivery Review that identified key opportunities for performance improvement through:

- (a) Identify options and opportunities to change services and service levels;
- (b) Obtain comparative data including bench marking our services and programs with comparable municipalities;
- (c) Recommend solutions to deliver the most efficient and cost-effective services and programs.

The following is an identified opportunity from the Review:

- A comprehensive review of position descriptions, roles and responsibilities will identify further opportunities for service delivery improvement.
- CAO to lead process to review all position descriptions to remove duplication of tasks, clarify responsibilities.

ANALYSIS:

Administration is recommending an initiative to develop a non-union compensation program that is internally equitable and competitive to the external market. The last organizational review was conducted in 2011 and 2012, by CAO Michael Larocque. Since that time, the Township has experienced significant growth.

At the time of the last review, the review showed that the Township had one of the lowest compensation grids for non-union staff. Since that time yearly COLA and job

rate grid increases (currently a 10-step grid) has incrementally closed the gap between the Township pay levels and local peer averages, but since this time no further review of our compensation program has been conducted.

Administration believes the current staff additions and job description responsibilities make this a timely exercise.

Augusta must remain competitive to retain its current employees and attract future ones. In the municipal world there is significant turnover as other jobs become available in neighbouring municipalities. The investment made in staff through training, time, and knowledge transfer (including corporate knowledge) is lost to other Municipalities due to higher salaries.

It is important to note that the Service Delivery Review had several findings that could be implemented and build on services available to all residents, but there needs to be qualified knowledgeable staff in place to implement them.

The project will be overseen by the CAO to ensure local knowledge and understanding will contribute significantly to the direction of the consultants process.

The cost of such a review is expected to be covered through the Municipal Modernization Funds, currently in Reserves.

PURPOSE:

To update Council of the activities and operations of the Public Works Department.

BACKGROUND:

Road Maintenance and Operations

- Residential entrance culvert installations are ongoing.
- Road patrol is ongoing.
- Hardtop maintenance (pothole repair) is ongoing.
- Sign installations are ongoing.
- Dangerous tree removal is ongoing throughout the Township. Currently working in Cedar and Kemp parks.
- Roadside noxious weed spraying is completed.
- Litter cleanup (ditches) is ongoing.
- Roadside mowing, deep ditch mowing and weed eating is ongoing.

Projects/Tenders:

- Speed Radars continue to monitor and collect traffic data (on-going rotation schedule and targeted locations, subject to requests for service).
- Infrastructure Asset Mapping (catch basins, culverts, streetlights, etc.) continues to capture data and is being inputted into our MESH tracking system.
- Road reconstruction projects have started. Ditching and road asphalt complete. Road shoulders, driveway asphalt and ditch seeding remain for completion.
- Ditching (road ditch improvements) projects are ongoing throughout the Township on Cedar and Willow streets.
- South Campbell Road CN railway crossing complete (new engineered design).
- Kyle and Klitbo bridges dry hydrant projects complete.

- Road construction packer/tamper arrived and is being utilized with current construction projects.
- Public Works renovation tender being finalized and will be released shortly.
- Staff is generating good news stories and pictures for posting on the website pertaining to activities and projects involving Public Works.

Waste Transfer Sites and Wetlands:

- Transfer Sites: Traffic remains steady. Normal operations.
- Waste Sites: Monitoring/testing is ongoing.
- Wetlands monitoring/testing is ongoing.
- Amnesty Day was June 26th, 2021. It was well received by residents.
- Pitch-In Day was July 3rd, 2021.
