My name is Ami Gagné, and I am the Project Coordinator of Municipal Solutions at Food Cycle Science. Our company provides municipalities with innovative solutions for residential food waste diversion to reduce the quantity of organics going into landfills. We are requesting to attend a Council meeting as delegates on November 22nd, 2021.

Our company has received federal funding from the Impact Canada and Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada's Food Waste Reduction Challenge to expand our municipal residential tood waste diversion program. We are currently working with eighteen Canadian municipalities across six provincesferristricies, including communities such as Trent Lakes, Bancroft and Neebing. The municipal program comes with direct investment into your community to offset the cost of the program. We are seeking additional implementation partners to be part of this program. With no green bins program in place, we believe that the Augusta Township would be a great fit.

FoodCyder is an "accelerated composter" that transforms food waste into a natural soil amendment in just a few hours, right in your own home. Upon processing the food waste through the FoodCycler, the weight and volume of the food waste are reduced by –90, leaving users with a pathogen-free and sterile biomass with many beneficial uses (E.g., natural fertilizer for one's garden or as a replacement fuel source for home heating). For municipalities with the FoodCycler, no green bin collection or processing intrastructure is required, and GHGs are reduced by 95% in comparison to sending food waste to landfills. Every FoodCycler deployed is estimated to divert at least 2 tonnes of food over its expected illetime. Furthermore, every tonne of food waste diverted from landfills is estimated to reduce greenhouse gas errissions by 1.3 tonnes of CO2e before transportation emissions. This can result in lower operating costs, fewer garbage trucks on the road and an extended lifespan for landfills. Not only that, but a food waste diversion pilot program would allow your residents to take part in an innovative solution to tighting climate change.

Municipalities will often bear the material and financial burdens of dimate change. With more at stake than higher levels of government, we believe that municipalities have a unique position in fighting climate change. As a first step, we would like to appear as a delegation (virtually) before Council to share information.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

**THAT** Council receives this report regarding the wooden ice rink boarding at Cedar Park;

**THAT** Council authorize staff to purchase new rink boarding for Cedar Park with the cost being included in the 2022 budget.

# **BACKGROUND:**

The condition of the current wooden boarding is unsafe. Many wooden parts are broken, loose and/or damaged, screws are sticking out and edges are ruff. This creates a situation where it is likely for people to get hurt.





To offer a safe environment and high-quality ice rink boarding for the volunteers and residents in this area, the ice rink boarding needs to be replaced.

Staff researched the different replacement options available on the market and concluded that the system from EZ-ICE is the best available option. They offer a high-quality system that is easy to build and store and offers the opportunity to extend the size of the rink and/or the height of the boarding.

Staff recommends replacement of the current boarding with 'EZ-ICE PRO Home Arena System 40x80' for the total amount of \$7,600.00.

# **FINANCIAL IMPACTS:**

In order to facilitate the recommended ice rink boarding for the 2021-2022 season and the years to follow, pre-budget approval is being sought.

This effectively incorporates a second signatory to electronic payments similar to the requirement to have two authorized signatures on a cheque.
Segregation of Duties re: Payroll Cycle  During the course of previous audits we determined that the same employee is responsible for the entire payroll cycle. This employee is able to both add and delete employees to the system, alter wage rates, and release the payroll report to the payroll service. The employee has the ability to redirect funds from the Township via alteration of wages rates, or creation of fictitious employees. While we understand the payroll is reviewed by management after it is prepared, our key concern is that the one employee has access to the entire payroll	We continue to recommend that one step in the payroll cycle require electronic approval by the Treasurer or member of the management team before the electronic file can be released to the payroll service, before wage rates can be altered, or before an employee can be added to the system. This will help ensure the assets of the Township are protected.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

**THAT** Council endorse speed limits of 60km/h for North Campbell Road and the portion of Dejong Road between Algonquin Road and Sixth Concession Road and direct Township staff to erect appropriate signage; and

**THAT** Council direct staff to erect stop signs on North Campbell Road at the McIntosh Road intersection creating an all way stop intersection.

#### **PURPOSE:**

Following Council's direction to follow up with a report regarding speed limit reductions and provide recommendations accordingly.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Two delegations were presented to Council requesting speed limit reductions on North Campbell Road and Dejong Road - the section between Algonquin Road and the Sixth Concession (see attached). These delegations were similar with both asking to lower the speed limits on the respective roads. Concerns brought forward when the delegations were presented included apparent speeding, safety concerns due to narrow to no shoulders for pedestrians, cyclists and people in general to use the road for exercise.

#### **ANALYSIS:**

North Campbell and Dejong Roads are currently 80km/h. The reduced speed limits on these roads will have minimal impact on traffic flow as the reduction in speed will add approximately thirty seconds of travel time for these portions of road. Current traffic speed data indicates an 85<sup>th</sup> percentile speed of 70km/h, respectively.

It is anticipated these changes will allow for better accommodation between traffic and pedestrians sharing the road from a safety standpoint.

During field investigations relating to the North Campbell Road delegation, it was noticed that there is a safety issue at the intersection on McIntosh and North Campbell Roads. Due to questionable sight lines caused by the vertical and horizontal alignment of the intersecting roadways, it is highly advisable that the Township erect stop signs creating a three way stop.

#### **POLICY IMPLICATIONS:**

No current Township transportation policy.

#### FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Signs and workforce to erect signs is approximately \$200.

### 1. Site Plan Control Application: 2328 Second Concession Road (Coville)

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Augusta Council approved the Site Plan Control Application of Todd Coville to enable the development of four structures for commercial/storage purposes on the property municipally known as 2328 Second Concession Road in 2018.

This followed a rezoning of the subject lands to a Rural Special Exception Zone in 2017, approved with the passing of By-law 3296-2017, which permitted the Mini Warehouse and Public Storage use.

An updated application to effectively amend the size and placement of structures on the originally approved site plan was deemed complete by the Planner on October 22, 2021, and was subsequently circulated to reviewing agencies.

At the time of drafting this report, the only agency to raise concerns about the application was Hydro One, due to the high voltage corridor which extends through the subject lands. The Planner corresponded with Hydro One about this proposal's intent to situate the fourth building farther away from the high voltage corridor than originally approved, and Hydro One acknowledged that the Planner intended to recommend that Council approve the application subject to conditions, including that the requirements of Hydro One be satisfied prior to development proceeding.

Other reviewers, including the Ministry of Transportation, the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville, and multiple internal departments did not object to the proposed development moving ahead.

Comments about the application were received from the adjacent neighbours to the west, who expressed concerns about the adequacy of drainage/water management within the subject lands, the proximity of commercial storage activities to their residence, and the removal of vegetation which took place to enable levelling and groundwork for the proposed fourth structure.

In analyzing the aerial imagery available for the 2008 and 2014 years, the boundary established for "Significant Woodlands" under the 2012 Official Plan did not correlate well with the actual location of significant woodlands, which are located to the north of the proposed fourth structure. Furthermore, in reviewing site imagery from 2013-2014, it is clear that the vegetation between the mini warehouse/public storage buildings and the adjacent residence was relatively sparse and generally low to the ground, with the exception of some affected ash trees which were deemed necessary to remove.

The Township's Planner and Public Works Manager/Drainage Superintendent completed a site visit and discussed the applicant's plans in detail, and also reviewed the stormwater management responsibilities of individual property owners under common law drainage. Trees identified in the proposed site plan along the western property line are intended to provide some screening between the properties and also to make use of existing drainage patterns within the subject lands.

The location of the proposed structures conforms with the setback requirements of the Zoning By-Law, and the rezoning of the property did not explicitly limit the number or specific placement of mini storage buildings.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

**THAT** Augusta Council approve the Site Plan Control Application (Coville) for the property municipally known as 2328 Second Concession Road with the following conditions:

- The applicant shall submit a stormwater/drainage management plan/brief to the satisfaction of the Township's Drainage Superintendent.
- The applicant shall install screening between the proposed storage units and the
  adjacent residence to the west, to the satisfaction of the Township, including the
  trees/landscaping identified in the site plan along the property boundary to the
  west, prior to November 22, 2022, or completion of the fourth structure,
  whichever is later.
- The applicant shall satisfy the requirements of Ontario Hydro as provided in their letter to the Township dated November 16, 2021, such that Ontario Hydro provides a written release of their conditions to the Township.

- The applicant shall direct lighting downward to minimize the impact of light intrusion on adjacent lands.
- The applicant shall enter into a Site Plan Control Agreement with the Township and register the agreement on title.

#### **OPTIONS:**

Augusta Council may:

- 1. Approve the Site Plan Control Application with the recommended conditions.
- 2. Approve the Site Plan Control Application with different conditions.
- 3. Defer approval of the Site Plan Control Application.

#### **CONSULTATION:**

The Ministry of Transportation and the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville provided comments. The Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit, South Nation Conservation, Township Senior Management, as well as the school boards, Ontario Hydro and other utility agencies were also circulated the application. Adjacent residents to the west provided comments via phone and email about the site plan control application and proposed development.

#### LINK TO MUNICIPAL PLANS:

The recommendation supports the planning principles and policies for growth, development and land use established in Augusta's Official Plan and Zoning By-law.

#### 2. Land Use Authority for Telecommunication Tower Applications

#### **BACKGROUND:**

In 2015, Augusta staff report 2015-052 recommended that the Township become a member of the Canadian Radiocommunications Information and Notification Service (CRINS), a not-for-profit agency which assists municipalities with the review of telecommunications tower proposals. Augusta Council voted to join CRINS and adopt their Antenna System Review and Consultation Protocol. A Joining Letter was then sent to CRINS authorizing the agency to act on the Township's behalf in the review and processing of telecommunications tower proposals.

Although the membership seemed promising at the time, the findings from recent stakeholder consultation by the Planner suggest that this membership may have stunted the Township's progress with respect to cellular and internet tower development due to the additional time, fees and steps involved for proponents. Developers of cellular and internet towers may have sought out municipalities with faster, less costly and less intensive approval processes.

While multiple other municipalities in Leeds-Grenville had signed up with CRINS around the same time, Augusta Township remains the only lower-tier municipality in the United Counties with membership in CRINS and our number of applications for towers is less than that of other lower-tier municipalities in Leeds-Grenville over the 2015-2021 period.

Augusta Township's membership with CRINS remains in place until it is cancelled by Council. There is not a contract with CRINS per se, although Augusta Council passed two resolutions and a Joining Letter was sent to CRINS pursuant to the recommendations of staff report 2015-052.

When telecommunications towers were much less common in the rural landscape and digital connectivity was not the priority that it has become as the COVID-19 pandemic has persisted, some members of the public had expressed concerns relating to matters such as impacted viewscapes and the potential unknown health effects of communications towers. However, as telecommunications towers have become more commonplace and more data has become available, advocacy by agencies such as the Eastern Ontario Regional Network (EORN) has increased, and the siting and consultation processes of telecommunications service providers have become more standardized, concern has shifted to ensuring that better rural cellular and internet service can be made available to more community members as quickly as possible.

Industry Canada reports that impasses are rare, with their involvement only being required to make a decision on less than 0.1% of telecommunications tower applications. As telecommunications service providers become larger, the incentive is present for such companies to maintain well-planned and well-consulted standardized processes for tower siting and design as part of their regular reputation management and business practices.

Meanwhile, the desire of Augusta residents for improved service has been a theme repeated in recent business and community surveys, and the Township's 2012 Zoning By-Law widely permitted the use of communications facilities on lands with Rural zoning throughout the municipality.

In building the regional network, there is a preference built into the siting system for proponents to investigate possibilities for situating towers on underutilized municipal properties, which can result in a series of regular payments to the Township over the duration of the land lease term.

The Industry Canada Client Procedures Circular (CPC) 2014 guideline for Radiocommunication and Broadcasting Antenna Systems states that proponents must follow Industry Canada's Default Public Consultation Process where the local land-use authority does not have an established and documented public consultation process applicable to antenna siting.

The established CPC guideline highlights three steps in Industry Canada's Default Public Consultation Process whereby the proponent:

- 1. Provides written notification to the public, the land-use authority and Industry Canada of the proposed antenna system installation or modification (i.e. public notification);
- 2. Engages the public and the land-use authority in order to address relevant questions, comments and concerns regarding the proposal (i.e. responding to the public); and
- 3. Provides an opportunity to the public and the land-use authority to formally respond in writing to the proponent regarding measures taken to address reasonable and relevant concerns (i.e. public reply comment).

Multiple area municipalities have advised that they intend on updating their established antenna siting protocols and procedures. Should the municipality wish to develop its own protocol, there may be opportunities for collaboration with such municipalities. To inform the development of local protocols, both the Federation of Canadian Municipalities and Eastern Ontario Regional Network have assembled guides for local municipalities wishing to do this.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

**WHEREAS** expediting applications for strategically located telecommunications towers to enable the provision of enhanced cellular, internet and emergency communication services to Augusta residents is a priority for the Council of the Township of Augusta;

**THAT** the Mayor be authorized to sign a letter on behalf of the Township discontinuing its membership with CRINS, with the understanding that CRINS will complete the processing of its sole remaining 2021 application currently under review on behalf of the Township;

**THAT** the Township of Augusta discontinue use of the CRINS Antenna System Review and Consultation Protocol, with the exception of the sole remaining 2021 application currently under review by CRINS on behalf of the Township;

**THAT** the Treasurer collect all payments owing from CRINS, up to and including payment for the 2021 application currently under review by CRINS;

**THAT** the Township of Augusta reaffirm itself as Land Use Authority (LUA) for telecommunications tower land use reviews in Augusta Township, for all telecommunications tower applications received starting November 23, 2021;

**AND THAT** Township staff cooperate with proponents of telecommunication towers to explore possibilities for their timely installation, including on lands that already permit communications facilities under the Augusta Zoning By-Law and on underutilized municipally owned lands where practical.

#### **POLICY IMPLICATIONS:**

Discontinuing membership in CRINS and use of the CRINS Antenna System Review and Consultation Protocol will put in place the default Industry Canada consultation protocol until such time as the Township may adopt its own specific protocol for siting antennas.

#### FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

There may be higher requirements for planning staff or consultants' time, comparable to processing other types of planning applications. However, the Township has already established fees for such reviews, some municipal involvement during the CRINS process is already required, and there are also costs to the municipality of not having the cellular and internet services available for residents that require improvement of these services.

#### **OPTIONS:**

Augusta Council may:

- 1. Continue membership with CRINS and have CRINS continue to review and process all telecommunications tower applications in the Township.
- 2. Discontinue membership with CRINS and have planning staff review and process all telecommunications tower applications in the Township.

#### **CONSULTATION:**

The Planner surveyed all of the member municipalities across the United Counties of Leeds and Grenville, multiple proponents of telecommunications towers and their site acquisition representatives, as well as representatives from the Eastern Ontario Regional Network (EORN). CRINS was also contacted directly for details to inform this report.

#### **LINK TO MUNICIPAL PLANS:**

Enabling expansion of cellular and internet towers supports the recommendations and expectations for growth and development established in Augusta's Official Plan and Zoning By-Law.





The Mayor and the proper officers of the Municipality are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said action or to obtain approvals where required, and except where otherwise provided, the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf, and the said Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to affix the Corporate Seal of the Municipality to all such documents.
